* * * Self-Managed Efficiency Programs * * *

Sec. __ 30 V.S.A. §209(j)(4)(A) is amended to read:

(A) A member of the transmission or industrial electric rate classes shall be eligible to apply to participate in the self-managed energy efficiency program class if the charges to the applicant or its predecessor company having the same facility under subdivision (d)(3) of this section were a minimum of \$1.5 million during calendar year 2008

Problem with 30 V.S.A. §209(j)(4)(A): GlobalFoundries would not qualify to participate in the self-managed energy efficiency program class because the company was not subject to energy efficiency charges under 30 V.S.A. §209(d)(3) of \$1.5 million or greater during the calendar year of 2008.

Intent: To amend 30 V.S.A. §209(j)(4)(A) so to ensure the qualification of GlobalFoundries to participate in the self-managed energy efficiency program class. It is also IBM's intent to amend the language in a manner that would qualify GlobalFoundried but otherwise not unintentionally add new eligibility to the self-managed energy efficiency program class.
