I urge you to reconsider the language of H.57, specifically item c as shown in the image attached. This language means that the death of an embryo or fetus would not be considered wrongful or a prosecutable offense should death occur as a result of injury to the mother carrying the child, regardless of whether the mother wanted or was going to carry the pregnancy to term. This denies grieving mothers and fathers justice in the unfortunate circumstance of wrongful death inflicted upon the unborn.

Please do not vote to approve this bill as written. While i can support a woman's right to choose, the downstream implications of this language are disasterous ans paramount to our collective reverence to life itself.
