3 Subject: Municipal and county government; municipal quasi-judicial
4 proceedings; temporary provisions

5 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to authorize
6 municipalities to hold any municipal quasi-judicial proceeding through
7 electronic means and suspend requirements for certain in-person inspections of
8 property subject to appeal.

9 An act relating to temporary municipal proceedings provisions in response
10 to the COVID-19 outbreak

11 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

12 Sec. 1. MUNICIPAL QUASI-JUDICIAL PROCEEDINGS; TEMPORARY
13 SUSPENSION OF IN-PERSON HEARING AND INSPECTION
14 REQUIREMENTS

15 (a) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, during a declared
16 state of emergency under 20 V.S.A. chapter 1 due to COVID-19, a
17 municipality is authorized to conduct any municipal quasi-judicial proceeding
18 through electronic means, provided that the municipality complies with all
19 other requirements for the conduct of the proceeding. The municipal

1 corporation shall not be required to designate a physical location for the
2 proceeding.

3 (b) Notwithstanding 32 V.S.A. § 4404(c), during a declared state of
4 emergency under 20 V.S.A. chapter 1 due to COVID-19, a board of civil
5 authority shall not be required to physically inspect any property that is the
6 subject of an appeal.
