We are seeking copies of all proposed drafts of the new Vermont State Police Media policy/policies that the state police say was shipped to the office of Governor Peter Shumlin or his staff for review. (I believe this could have been as much as November 2013.)

Please include any and all records and communications -- written, electronic or otherwise -- including, but not limited to emails, reports, letters, memos, messages, text messages, voice mails etc. with any and all follow-up discussion, messages or communications between the Department of Public Safety/Vermont State Police and the Governor and/or members of his staff.

As noted we are looking for all drafts, including any that were rejected or sent back with comments and/or for re-write or further consideration.

We have been told that at least one policy was forwarded there more than a year ago. What ever happened to that proposal?
