

16 V.S.A. § 261a(a) Current Duties of Supervisory Union Boards (4/29/15)

(W) = SU Board may request a waiver from the Secretary of Education if it believes the services could be provided more efficiently and effectively in whole or in part at the district level

- establish an SU-wide curriculum either by developing it or assisting member districts to develop it jointly (1)
 - ensure implementation (1)
 - assist schools to follow it (2)
 - review compatibility of curriculum with schools outside of SU in which resident students are enrolled (3)
- establish and implement a plan to receive and disburse federal and State funds (4)
- provide professional development programs or arrange for them, or both (5)
- provide SpEd services on behalf of its member districts **(W)** (6)
- employ all licensed & nonlicensed SU employees (implied by and subject to § 242(3)), including person providing financial and student data management services for the SU and member districts (7)
- manage a system to procure/distribute goods & operational services for districts **(W)** (8)(A)
- manage all construction projects for districts **(W)** (8)(B)
- provide financial management services for districts **(W)** (8)(C)
- provide student data management services for districts **(W)** (8)(C)
- negotiate with teachers, administrators, & other personnel (terms may vary by district) **(W)** (8)(D)
- provide or arrange for the provision of transportation, or both, in any district that offers it **(W)** (8)(E)
- provide human resources management services for districts **(W)** (8)(F)
- provide financial breakdown of SU expenses (10)
- adopt an SU budget (11)
- adopt SU-wide truancy policies (12)
