Expenses for Town Poor

To the Hon. the Legislature next to be holden
at Montpelier, on the second Thursday of Oct. 1829.

The number of paupers, for the year preceding
the first Monday of March 1829. in the Town
of St Albans, and by said town ~~wholly~~ supported
and in the whole or in part are — — 12.00

In addition one Turnover — & also a Scotch } — 7.00
Famity — supported in part — 19.00
making Nineteen in the whole —

There are included in the above three colored
persons — two males & one female —

The whole amount of ~~these~~ expenses for
supporting the ab^d paupers for the } \$5-46,50
year preceding is Five hundred & eighty six dollars & fifty cents

It is difficult to assign the causes ~~which~~ which
have reduced the ab^d persons to pauperism — for
some of them, partly by intemperance —

There are only ~~Two~~ which in the opinion of the
Overseer, was caused by intemperance solely —

There is one Law suit now pending in the
Supreme Court — between the Town of Georgia vs
St Albans — the amount of expenses
not yet ascertained —

The manner of supporting the above paupers are by
employing such persons as preferred to support them
at the least sum. &
