Dear Alex –

We are continuing to review the Telecommunications bill and will have info for you first thing in the morning on the stormwater provisions and anything else we find overnight. Meantime:

- 1) Scenic corridors issue
  - a. Found it on page 7, line 21 – **this is good, we like it.**
- 2) License and lease authority – pg 30, lines 4-9
  - a. This is problematic for the reasons you identified – it strips the agency of all license and lease authorities that will have wide-ranging effects – we'll give you some examples tomorrow. It also still attempts to vest the authority in Sec of Administration. **This is bad and should be deleted.** Good catch, thanks!

More to come tomorrow morning, but hope this helps in the meantime. Thanks so much,
