Phase 1 (6 months)

Start and Complete Rulemaking Process, appoint Marijuana Control Board housed at DPSafety

Allow for personal possession of X by 21 and up – residents v. non-resident?

Allow existing dispensaries to expand their inventory (in door grow only) in anticipation of retail sales – applications for additional cultivation and retail allowed

Allow two additional dispensaries

Phase 2 (one year)

X number of licenses [retailer and cultivator] get issued at X cost with each retail licensee allowed to open X number of stores. Limit how many licenses any one entity can own to avoid large corporate involvement(?).

Stores may only sell useable plant materials – no edibles

Each sale is limited to X quantity of useable material for VT resident, X for non-resident

No comingling of medical patients and retail purchasers at dispensaries.

Use only allowed in private(???). Hotel decide whether to allow lounge? Transport secured container(?).

Open up applications for cultivator licenses (individuals who may grow more than the personal possession amount for sale to retail locations)

Applications accepted for additional stores (and/or expand # of stores existing licensees may own)

Impairment law effective, possible CO threshold, possible civil suspension

Phase 3

Other non-edible products may be sold in stores for non-smoke methods of consumption

Allow for formation of sharing cooperatives(?)

Expand number of licenses, cultivator and retail
