Lt. Governor Molly Gray to visit Central Vermont Home Health & Hospice and Central Vermont Adult Basic Education, Inc.

What: Lt. Governor Molly Gray will visit Central Vermont Home Health & Hospice and meet with CEO Sandy Rousse, COO Kim LaGue, and Home Care Manager Sarah Rowan to discuss workforce development and retention in home health and hospice and long-term care services. Central Vermont Home Health and Hospice is a full service, not-for-profit Visiting Nurse Association that provides medically necessary home health and hospice care to all Central Vermonters, regardless of their ability to pay. CVHHH provides care to residents of over two dozen towns in Washington and Orange Counties.

Lt. Governor Gray will visit Central Vermont Adult Basic Education's Barre learning center and meet with CVABE leadership to discuss their effort to provide free education opportunities for adults to obtain the academic skills necessary to be active community and workforce members.
