Dear Ms. Lipinski:

This is in response to your access to records request dated October 11, 2016. Your request seeks all e-mail correspondence, including attachments, exchanged between Lt. Governor Scott, Rachel Feldman or Nancy Driscoll/Nancy Brooks and 20 different email accounts from January, 2011 through October 11, 2016.

To complete this request, we searched all three e-mail accounts for the 19 specific e-mail addresses listed in your letter, as well as a general search of all three e-mail accounts for the @rga.org domain. This returned 33 pages of responsive documents. Three responsive documents (3 pages) are direct communication between an individual with an @rga.org e-mail address and Lt. Governor Scott. Three responsive documents (3 pages) are direct communication between drexrode@rga.org and Rachel Feldman requesting to be on the Lt. Governor's office's public distribution list. The remaining 16 responsive documents (27 pages) are emails containing Lt. Governor Scott's public schedule and press releases sent to drexrode@rga.org per his request to be on the public distribution list.

A PDF file of all responsive documents is attached. You will note we have redacted personal cell phone numbers from the body of emails as they constitute personal information.

The total amount of senior-level staff time spent complying with your request was 305 minutes. I am authorized to charge you for the time that exceeds the first 30 minutes, which totals \$156.75 for senior-level staff time to comply with this request (57¢ per minute) and \$.66 for 33 pages of computer-generated paper copies. As you have already remitted a check for \$100, please remit a second check made payable to the State of Vermont in the amount of \$57.41 to cover the remaining balance.
