

Explanation of Version 1.7 of Sen. Appropriations Amendment to S.241

1. Change to revenue provision in Intent section of the act
2. Sen. Transportation amendment clarifying that no entitlement to use mj while engaged in scope of employment
3. Technical amendment to Finance amendment
4. Establishment of the new fund

11. Sen. Transportation amendment disqualifying driver for one year if person refuses a blood test looking for mj
12. Sen. Transportation amendment adding Secretary of Transportation to work with Commissioner of Public safety on reporting impaired driving data and recommendations to the Governor and General Assembly
13. Strikes the DRE funding section, but adds in a section that notes the importance of training and directs Cole and Flynn to use available funds to train officers
14. Strikes the appropriations in the Judiciary amendment and puts in new sections on appropriations, positions, and reporting
15. Amendments to effective dates
