

1 Draft Request 20-0946 – draft 4.1

2 (temporary elections provisions in response to COVID-19)

3 Representative Mrowicki of Putney moves that the bill be amended in

4 Sec. 2, (voter signatures), in subsection (b) (“In the year 2020:”), by adding a

5 subdivision (4) to read:

6 (4) A person shall be prohibited from having the person’s name printed

7 on the ballot for more than one office in either the primary or general election.

8 Accordingly, a person shall be prohibited from filing more than one consent of

9 candidate form for either the primary or general election. However, such a

10 person may still win any office in the primary or general election as a write-in

11 candidate.
