Pursuant to Vermont's "Public Records" Act, 1 V.S.A. 315-320, I request copies of the following records. Please provide in electronic form if possible.

-All correspondence issued or received by the Shumlin administration, including Robert Sand, regardless of physical form, regarding the state's Pretrial Services program

- also called "pre-charge" program -

that was established through the passage of Act 195.

This request includes but is not limited to all correspondence between Robert Sand and states attorneys and/or Dept. of State's Attorneys and Sheriffs regarding the Pretrial Services program

I am addressing this request to you in the belief that you are the custodian of such documents. If you are not, I request that you forward my request to the proper custodian of such documents and inform me of who that person is.

I agree to pay reasonable and customary costs for these copies.

If the law does not allow me to have access to some of these records, please so inform me within three business days, as provided by law, and inform me of the specific exemption that applies to each record or portion of a record being withheld. If an otherwise public record has a portion that is exempt from disclosure, please redact the exempt portion and release a copy of the rest of the document together with a notation of the specific exemption that applies to the redacted portion.

If some or all of my request is denied, please tell me the title and name of the person responsible for the denial and, as the law

requires, please inform me of the appeal procedures available to me and the name of the person to whom appeal may be made. If you have questions about this request, please call me at [617-416-1820](tel:617-416-1820).
